THE KORALM RAILWAY – A MILESTONE FOR CARINTHIA

arinthia is moving closer to central markets, as the Koralm Railway adds a new dimension to mobility from the end of 2025. It will connect over 1.1 million people, enable daily commuting and offer companies and logistics enterprises a more efficient flow of goods, which is a clear advantage of locating in Carinthia in the Alpine-Adriatic region.

With the completion of the Koralm Railway and its centrepiece, the Koralm Tunnel, Carinthia will be even more accessible and more closely connected with Styria from the end of 2025. The new high-speed line will directly connect Klagenfurt, Villach and Graz to create a completely new mobility dimension as well as a dynamic economic and living space in southern Austria. The reduced travel time will bring the urban centres closer together and allow a daily commute between them for the first time – the ideal prerequisite for specialists, companies and investors alike.

Carinthia also relies on flexible transport systems away from the main hubs and likewise on future-oriented mobility solutions.

SEMMERING BASE TUNNEL AND KORALM TUNNEL – EVEN MORE OPPORTUNITIES FOR CARINTHIA

The Semmering Base Tunnel, another central project of the new southern rail route, will create a faster and more efficient rail connection between Vienna, Graz and Carinthia by 2030. While the Koralm Tunnel will provide a direct link between Klagenfurt and Graz from the end of 2025, the Semmering Base Tunnel will provide an even better connection between the entire southern rail route and the economic centres in the north of Austria and beyond.

Carinthia benefits from shorter transport times

The Semmering Base Tunnel will make the existing rail connections between Carinthia and Vienna significantly faster and more reliable. After the Koralm Tunnel's opening, the travel time on the southern rail route from Klagenfurt to Vienna via Semmering will be only 2 hours and 40 minutes. The new Semmering Base Tunnel will save up to an additional 40 minutes, which will significantly reduce travel times for passengers and goods transport. This means that a train journey from Klagenfurt to Vienna will only take around two hours from 2030.

More efficient goods traffic for Carinthia


The new southern rail route is therefore not only an essential asset for Carinthia in terms of passenger transport, but also one of the most important transit routes for rail goods traffic between Central and South-Eastern Europe. The Semmering Base Tunnel reduces the gradients and bottlenecks that previously slowed down the transit of goods. This means:

- More cost-efficient and faster transportation for Carinthian companies
- Increased capacity for goods trains as the line becomes more efficient
- Direct connection to large logistics centres such as Logistik Center Austria Süd in Fürnitz, which acts as a central transshipment point for goods from Italy, Slovenia and Eastern Europe

CARINTHIA AS A STRATEGIC LOGISTICS HUB

Carinthia is located at the intersection between Central Europe and the growth markets in Southern and Eastern Europe. Well-developed infrastructure connects Carinthia with the largest economic regions in Europe and offers a wide range of advantages:

- · Direct connection to the Baltic-Adriatic Axis
- Fast connections to the Adriatic ports of Koper, Trieste and Rijeka
- Efficient connections to Germany, Italy, Slovenia and Eastern Europe
- Intermodal transportation options by road, rail and air



LOGISTIK CENTER AUSTRIA SÜD – EFFICIENCY MEETS INNOVATION

Logistik Center Austria Süd – a strategic hub for logistics and industry

Logistik Center Austria Süd (LCA Süd) is located on one of Europe's most important transport axes and, as a joint venture between Kärntner Beteiligungsverwaltung (KBV, the Carinthian Investment Administration) and the Austrian Federal Railways (ÖBB), connects central economic areas. Targeted sector development with a focus on the food and logistics industries creates the ideal conditions for companies wishing to benefit from a favourable location, modern infrastructure and a dynamic economic region.

A business location around Logistik Center Austria Süd and the Villach/Fürnitz logistics centre offers companies decisive advantages – from fast connections to European markets to tailor-made settlement strategies for future-oriented industries.

The benefits in three points:

Excellent transport connections

The properties of Logistik Center Austria Süd benefit from a strategically advantageous location along the Baltic-Adriatic Axis and the Tauern Axis. This enables fast and efficient connections to the northern Adriatic ports as well as to economic centres in Germany, Poland, the Czech Republic and Slovenia.

Generous availability of space

On a total area of 160 hectares, Logistik Center Austria Süd offers optimally developed operating areas for companies from the production and logistics sectors. The areas are suitable for heavy traffic and equipped with comprehensive infrastructure, including water, electricity and gas supply.

Individual company services

Logistik Center Austria Süd supports companies with tailor-made services – from advice on land purchases and assistance with approval procedures to recruitment and the targeted search for suitable cooperation partners.



FOCUS ON CROSS-BORDER PROJECTS – NEW OPPORTUNITIES THROUGH MODERN INFRASTRUCTURE

The expansion of the transport infrastructure and the development of intermodal solutions are increasingly facilitating the implementation of cross-border projects between Austria, Italy and Slovenia. These developments open up new opportunities for international cooperation and optimised logistics solutions.


Intermodality as a competitive advantage Carinthia offers ideal conditions for companies that use both road and rail for the fast, efficient transportation of goods

Innovative projects and partnerships Carinthia and Logistik Center Austria Süd create optimal conditions for the realisation of cross-border initiatives in the areas of logistics, production and distribution. One outstanding example is the Interreg project FOODIS, which strengthens cooperation in the food industry across national borders and makes value chains more sustainable and resilient.

The Carinthian Agri Food Hub platform was launched by Logistik Center Austria Süd together with partners from Carinthia and Friuli-Venezia Giulia. This digital platform simplifies the management of surplus food and serves as an innovation hub for the further processing of these products – for example into fruit and vegetable juices or spreads.







Cargo Terminal Villach Süd – efficiency and modern infrastructure for the logistics industry

The Cargo Terminal Villach Süd of the Austrian Federal Railways stands out with its state-of-the-art technical equipment and a wide range of services, making it an ideal location for logistics companies.

Powerful technical equipment

The terminal has a full-loaded container reach stacker with a load capacity of up to 45 tons and is designed for train lengths of up to 600 metres, which enables efficient and flexible handling of goods.

Comprehensive services

Companies benefit from a comprehensive range of services, including customs clearance, refrigeration and heating services, container repairs, empty container depots and specially designed transshipment tracks for conventional goods traffic.

Fürnitz large shunting yard - efficient hub for international goods traffic


The Fürnitz large shunting yard offers decisive advantages to companies that rely on efficient and optimised logistics solutions.

Optimised logistics processes

By reducing wagon turnaround times, accelerating train composition and minimising transport damage, the railway station significantly increases the efficiency of goods traffic.

International link

As a central hub and distribution centre for goods to and from Italy and South-Eastern Europe, the railway station ensures optimised distribution of shipments within Carinthia as well as to East Tyrol and Upper Styria.



Klagenfurt Airport - international accessibility

Klagenfurt Airport is an essential infrastructure facility and a strong partner for the Carinthian economy and local tourism. It is an important driving force in the southern Austrian economic region and a major employer in Carinthia with over 120 employees.

Opportunities for companies and investors

The improved accessibility of Carinthia provided by the Koralm Railway increases the importance of the airport as a multimodal transport hub and as a pivotal point for business and mobility. The combination of air and rail transport creates synergies that strengthen Carinthia as a business location in the long term. Klagenfurt Airport plays a key role here as a central hub for business travel, tourism and location development.

Investors and companies interested in relocating to Carinthia will find ideal international interconnectedness at Klagenfurt Airport, complemented by modern office and commercial spaces at and around the airport. Furthermore, close integration with international networks improves competitiveness.

Efficient business travel and connection to international markets




Diverse possibilities

The general aviation sector (private and business aviation), as well as flight schools and flying clubs, are an important part of Austria's southernmost commercial airport. They make a substantial contribution to the value chain in Carinthia.

Expansion and new potential uses

Significant and profitable investments are in the pipeline for the further successful development of Klagenfurt Airport. These include the construction of a new helicopter base, the expansion of office space for rental, the creation of modern event areas and a private flight terminal. Large areas not required for operations are available on site, which can be leased to strategic partners in the future.





LOGISTICS IN CARINTHIA: STRONG COMPANIES, INTERCONNECTED FUTURE

S everal major logistics companies operate in Carinthia, strengthening the location. They make a significant contribution to Carinthia's logistics infrastructure and support the regional economy with their wide range of services.

Examples:

DB Schenker

At Klagenfurt Airport, the freight forwarding company and logistics specialist DB Schenker operates a modern logistics terminal with its own railway siding. The facility comprises a 2,500 square metre transshipment hall, a 1,800 square metre logistics warehouse and a 1,200 square metre office wing for 130 employees.

Gebrüder Weiss

With a location in Maria Saal, Gebrüder Weiss offers comprehensive transport and logistics solutions. The company boasts a global network with around 180 bases in 34 countries.

MICRO-PUBLIC TRANSPORT – FLEXIBLE MOBILITY SOLUTIONS

The integration of micro-public transport systems in Carinthia plays a decisive role in the optimisation of regional mobility – especially in view of the imminent opening of the Koralm Railway in 2025. This combination strengthens Carinthia as a business location through improved accessibility and flexible transportation solutions.

Micro-public transport in Carinthia: flexible mobility for rural regions

Needs-based transportation options are offered that supplement public transport in less densely populated areas. They close gaps in the transport network and enable residents to be efficiently connected to larger transport hubs. One example of this is Kärnten Transfer, a shuttle service that is bookable online, connecting over 6,500 accommodation establishments with train stations and airports in the region.

The Carinthia 2035 Mobility Master Plan aims to fundamentally change mobility in Carinthia. Efforts are focused on improving accessibility to mobility services, environmental friendliness, safety and the further development of sustainable, efficient mobility services as well as improving accessibility to Carinthia's various regions.



Synergy effects through the Koralm Railway

The Koralm high-speed rail line will significantly improve accessibility and promote the development of a new urban agglomeration in the south of Austria. The combination of micro-public transport systems and the Koralm Railway creates the following advantages for Carinthia:

Extended labour market

Thanks to the improved connections, commuters have more flexibility of choice in where they live and work. This strengthens the regional labour market in Carinthia.

Attractiveness for companies

Companies benefit from a greater reach and can access an extended catchment area of specialists.


Population growth

The improved infrastructure can help to stop external migration trends and attract new residents.



THE SECOND TUNNEL TUBE OF THE KARAWANKEN TUNNEL – MORE SAFETY AND CAPACITY

The expansion of the Karawanken Tunnel represents a significant step forward for international trade. It is a clear signal of Carinthia's attractiveness as a hub in the Alpine-Adriatic region and underlines the importance of modern infrastructure for regional development and competitiveness. The construction of a second tunnel tube will increase road safety and expand the capacity of the important north-south connection between Austria and Slovenia. This project, which was launched in September 2018, is being carried out by Autobahnen- und Schnellstraßen-Finanzierungs-Aktiengesellschaft (ASFINAG) in cooperation with the Slovenian motorway operator, Družba za avtoceste v Republiki Sloveniji (DARS).

ALPINE INTERNET EXCHANGE – CARINTHIA AS A DIGITAL HUB IN THE ALPINE-ADRIATIC REGION

W ith the Alpine Internet Exchange (ALPSiX), Carinthia is creating a digital infrastructure of European significance. Inspired by Marseille's success as a leading internet hub, Carinthia will be directly connected to the international data highways of Arelion and EXA Infra/TürkTelekom with its own data node in Fürnitz.

Advantages of the new data infrastructure

- Reduction of latency times from currently around 20 ms to just 1 ms – essential for telemedicine, autonomous driving and smart city applications
- Direct data processing in Carinthia instead of detours via Vienna or Frankfurt – more data security and greater efficiency for companies
- Attractive location for data centres and digital companies, as such hubs have proven to be a magnet for IT and cloud service providers

A high-performance fibre-optic network for Carinthia


Parallel to the creation of the Alpine Internet Exchange, a fibre ring is being set up that:

- redundantly connects Lakeside Science & Technology
 Park in Klagenfurt and High Tech Campus in Villach and ensures a high-performance fibre-optic infrastructure,
- integrates Logistik Center Austria Süd into the digital network, creating an optimal combination of physical and digital infrastructure,
- connects Carinthia better internationally and makes the region more attractive for investors and technology-driven companies.

A location with a future

The Alpine Internet Exchange is not only a technological improvement, but also a strategic investment in Carinthia's competitiveness:

- International visibility as a digital location in the Alpine-Adriatic region
- Synergies with the Koralm Railway, international transport axes and the port of Trieste
- Live launch in early 2026 a decisive step towards positioning Carinthia as a preferred location for digital innovations and smart working environments
